Perfectly positioned on the outskirts of Bishop's Tachbrook, Oakley Grove is equidistant between the historic towns of Leamington Spa and Warwick.

Leamington Spa is a beautiful modern town, full of regency splendour and dramatic Georgian and Victorian architecture. The town offers a unique shopping experience, combining specialist boutiques and popular high street brands in a picturesque and traditional setting. Bursting with flavour, the town centre is also home to over 50 pubs, bars and restaurants, offering food from around the globe.

The Grade II listed Royal Pump Rooms, originally one of the town's finest spa baths, is now a centre for culture and tourism, housing both the public library and Leamington Art Gallery and Museum. The award-winning Jephson Gardens is a popular attraction for all ages thanks to the impressive fountain, beautiful floral displays and tropical Glasshouse.

Warwick is also a town steeped in history; the home of Warwick Castle, originally built by William the Conqueror in 1068, and Warwick Racecourse, where the first stand was built in 1808. Blending the old with the new, Warwick town centre is a bustling mix of independent retailers and antiques, traditional tea rooms and fine dining.

Bishop's Tachbrook itself is a picturesque village offering shops, a doctors surgery and a local public house. Full of community spirit, there is plenty for all the family to get involved with including the Bishop's Tachbrook football and cricket teams, baby and toddler groups, dance classes and book clubs.
